Two of the bills League has been supporting passed near the end of the cut-off. Those are:

- <u>HB 1673</u>, Concerning broadband infrastructure loans and grants made by the public works board. This bill was amended by the Senate and so amendments will have to be negotiated with the House and both chambers will need to pass the bill again.
- SB 5528, Authorizing voter-approved additive revenue sources within a regional transit authority area for enhanced service zones. This bill was amended by the House and so amendments will have to be negotiated with the Senate and both chambers will need to pass the bill again.

The House and Senate budgets will be reconciled next week, and in the next newsletter there will be a detailed explanation of what the Legislature ultimately passed.
