

Weekly Legislative Update: Early Care and Education

Most of the early care and education bills we support are now in Senate Ways and Means or House Appropriations. These bills need to be approved by the fiscal committees by February 24. These include: SB 5225, SB 5316, SB 5423, HB 1451, HB 1511, HB 1525, HB 1550, and HB 1633. (HB 1633 is scheduled for hearing on February 20 in the House Capital Budget Committee.)

<u>SB 5225</u> is scheduled for public hearing in Senate Ways and Means on February 20 at 9:00 am. This bill would expand the availability of child care including for children in immigrant families. Please sign in <u>PRO</u> on this bill at least an hour prior to the public hearing.

The two bills we noted last week as being of concern received hearings this week but did not pass out of their committees of origin. We appreciate you weighing in on HB 1537-Licensing requirements for child care centers and indoor early learning programs, and HB 1739-Concerning instruction for child care providers. While these bills died in committee (at least for this session), their public hearings raised questions about balancing child care quality, access and the viability of child care businesses. These questions are likely to continue.
