

#### INFLUENCING ELECTED OFFICIALS

- Have a specific ask
- •Do some homework, but not a lot.
- •Do NOT be intimidated.
- •Provide a 'leave behind'.

#### Prepare

- Frame the conversation
- Tell a story, not just data
- Talk values, not policy
- •Use benefit language
- Listen to their language
- Ask for a commitment




